ADOPTION AGREEMENT

I, _____, promise to tend and care for this tomato plant.

I understand that I should choose a sunny spot for my plant, 18 to 36 inches away from other plants, and that I should transplant the tomato by planting it deep into the soil. I will water the plant with one gallon of warm water within ten minutes of transplant.

I will water my plant with 16 ounces of water every day for the first week, then two to three times weekly following.
